1. Naval Ship Repair Yard (Sri Vijaya Puram) invites online applications on website <https://apprenticeship.recttindia.in/> from ITI qualified Indian National candidates (Male/Female) for "**Technician (Vocational) Apprentice Programme for One Year (IT-03 Batch)**" for the Training batch 2026-27 in accordance with Apprentices Act, 1961 read in conjunction with Apprenticeship Rules 1992 as amended from time to time in thirteen (13) designated trades for 50 vacancies as per distribution shown below:

Note: The number of vacancies mentioned above are only indicative and may change at a later stage during the final assessment of eligible candidates.

2. ELIGIBILITY CONDITIONS

2.1. Nationality and Character: Only Indian nationals can apply and be accepted into "Technician (Vocational) Apprentice Programme for One Year IT-03 Batch" at NSRY (Sri Vijaya Puram). The candidates should not have been convicted of offences or under trial or in the process to be charge sheeted or to be tried under any of the Indian laws or rules/regulations of the educational institutions. Since NSRY (Sri Vijaya Puram) is a defence establishment, applications of candidates with questionable or suspicious antecedents would be summarily rejected without any intimation to the candidate and if the subsequent police verification does not provide a clean certificate, the selected candidature would be cancelled.

2.2. Educational Qualification: Minimum educational qualification is matriculation followed by ITI passed in respective trades under NCVT or SCVT. Eligible ITI trades for designated trades will be as per Apprenticeship Rules, 1992, as amended from time to time.

2.3. Age: Minimum age limit is 18 years as on one day before the date of commencement of "Technician (Vocational) Apprentice Programme for One Year, IT-03 Batch" at NSRY (Sri Vijaya Puram). No upper age restriction for apprenticeship training as per Ministry of Skill Development and Entrepreneurship (MSDE) office memorandum No. F. No. MSDE-14(03)/2021 AP-(PMU) dated 20 Dec 21.

2.4. Physical Standards: The standard of Physical Fitness shall be as per Rule 4 and Schedule - II of Apprenticeship Rules, 1992. Candidates are to be examined by Yard Medical Officer of Naval Ship Repair Yard, Sri Vijaya Puram prior to enrolling.

2.5. Previous Training: Candidates who have already undergone or are currently undergoing Apprenticeship in the same trade under Apprentices Act, 1961 as amended time to time in any Govt/ public sector/ private industrial organization, are not eligible to apply for the current program.

3. RESERVATION OF VACANCIES

3.1. Reservation of vacancies will be as per Rule 5, Sub Rule (1) (amplification in Schedule II A) and Rule 5, Sub Rule (2) of Apprenticeship Rules, 1992 as applicable in the Union Territory of Andaman & Nicobar Islands and as amended time to time.

3.2. It is to be noted and clearly understood that while Naval Ship Repair Yard (Sri Vijaya Puram) located at Haddo, Sri Vijaya Puram is an equal opportunity provider and does not discriminate in the name of sex, race, caste, religion, place of birth or such other categorisations except otherwise as provided for in the law or the rules and regulations of the Union Territory of Andaman and Nicobar Islands, it is a defence establishment and is registered as a factory, which is engaged in activities considered 'risky, hazardous, physically demanding and arduous'. Accordingly, equal opportunities are provided and implemented considering and taking into account the nature of work and activities that NSRY (Sri Vijaya Puram) is engaged in, and 3% of vacancies are horizontally reserved for Persons with Disability who are otherwise eligible and meet the fitness relaxation criteria laid out in Rule 4 of Apprenticeship Rules, 1992.

3.3. For Armed Force Personnel / Ex-Serviceman (Ex-Ser): As per Section 3.6.3 of Chapter III of Apprenticeship Training Manual, 3% of overall vacancies are reserved for Ex-Servicemen, their children and children of armed forces personnel to be made as per the details mentioned below:

- 3.3.1.** Children of deceased/disabled Ex-Servicemen including those killed/disabled in peace time.
- 3.3.2.** Children of Ex-Servicemen.
- 3.3.3.** Children of Serving Jawans.
- 3.3.4.** Children of Serving Officers.
- 3.3.5.** Ex-Servicemen.

3.4. The vacancies provided for PwD and Ex-Servicemen in horizontal reservation system are adjusted in the appropriate category viz UR/OBC/SC/ST to which these belong.

3.5. In case the reserved vacancies cannot be filled due to non-availability of eligible candidates, the vacancies so lying unfilled will be filled by candidates not belonging to these categories.

3.6. The unfilled vacancies of a particular enrolment shall not be carried forward to the next enrollment as backlog.

4. PAYMENT OF STIPEND TO APPRENTICES

The apprentices will be paid monthly stipend in accordance with Apprenticeship Rules, 1992 or as revised by Government from time to time. This would be subject to registration of the candidate in online apprenticeship portal and execution of valid apprenticeship contract.

5. SELECTION OF CANDIDATES

5.1. Shortlisting of Candidates for Interview: Preliminary selection will be made on the basis of Merit List drawn out Trade and Category wise on the basis of their aggregate Percentage (%) of marks obtained in ITI trades and Std X. Candidates in the Preliminary Merit list will be called for Interview scheduled to be held at Apprentice Training School, Naval Ship Repair Yard, Sri Vijaya Puram. The Interview will carry 50 Marks. Candidates will be tested for technical skills in respective trade during interview. A call letter for Interview will be issued to all eligible candidates on their registered email ID post scrutiny of all necessary documents and through online communication. Candidates are advised to check their email regularly.

5.2. Final Merit List: Prepared by considering interview marks and in case of tie with same marks, candidate's date of birth will be compared, and the elder person will be placed above the others. In case of further ties, ascending alphabetical order of the first name followed by middle name and surname as mentioned in Std X certificate will be considered.

5.3. Document Verification: Candidates have to produce original documents before registration:

- 5.3.1. SSC / Matriculation Marks Certificate
- 5.3.2. ITI Certificate & Final consolidated marksheet (NCVT/SCVT)
- 5.3.3. Identity Proof (e.g. Aadhaar Card)
- 5.3.4. Caste Certificate (if applicable)

- 5.3.5. PwD Certificate (if applicable)
- 5.3.6. Ex-serviceman / Armed Force Personnel Certificate (if applicable)
- 5.3.7. NCC Certificate (if applicable)
- 5.3.8. Sports Certificate (if applicable)

5.4. Medical Examination: All applicants are required to get medical fitness certificate from Government Hospitals / Government Medical Officer.

6. NOTICES TO PROSPECTIVE CANDIDATES

In case of any change in schedule of dates, amendment, etc. the same will be intimated through online website mentioned at Para 1 above only.

7. COMMENCEMENT OF TRAINING

The Training is tentatively scheduled to commence on **01 Dec 26**. Final selected candidates will be offered apprenticeship contract for duration of one year as per the Apprentices Act, 1961 and Apprenticeship Rules, 1992.

8. TRAVEL EXPENSES & 9. BOARDING/LODGING

8. Travel Expenses: No travel expenses are admissible for candidates called for Interview, Document Verification & joining of Apprenticeship Training Program.

9. Boarding/Lodging: Candidates called for interview/document verification and apprenticeship training program are to arrange their own boarding and lodging. No arrangements will be provided by Naval Ship Repair Yard, Sri Vijaya Puram.

10. FILLING UP OF ONLINE APPLICATIONS

Candidates are required to register online at <https://apprenticeship.rectindia.in/> and fill up online application. The website for filling online application will open from the Third day (1000 hrs) of publication of Advertisement in Employment News and remain open up to **2359 hrs on 10 Oct 26**. The candidates are required to upload good quality/readable documents duly scanned in colour PDF only in A4 size and file size up to 200 kb:

- **10.1.** Passport size photo of candidate in Blue background (3.5 cm X 4.5 cm, up to 200 kb) in JPEG/JPG format.
- **10.2.** SSC / Matriculation (Std X) Mark Sheet and proof of Date of Birth (Birth Certificate or Aadhaar Card).
- **10.3.** ITI Certificate with final consolidated Mark sheet (NCVT/SCVT).
- **10.4.** Community Certificate for candidates seeking reservation as per Rule 5 Sub Rule (1) and Rule 5 Sub Rule (2) of Apprenticeship Rules 1992.
- **10.5.** Certificate of Physical Disability issued by competent authority for PwD category.
- **10.6.** Certificate of applicability in respect of candidates seeking reservation under Ward of Armed Forces Personnel / Ex-serviceman.
- **10.7.** Aadhaar Card of candidate (Compulsory) (file size up to 200 kb) in JPEG/JPG format.
- **10.8.** Self-photograph and photographs of documents taken from mobile phones/cameras are NOT acceptable.

11. TRADE TEST & PROSPECTS AFTER APPRENTICESHIP

Every full-term apprentice who completed the period of training shall appear for a test conducted by the respective Apprentice School or authorized agency. Passed apprentices shall be issued with National Apprenticeship Certificate (NAC) by Director General of Training (DGT).

12. OFFER & ACCEPTANCE OF EMPLOYMENT

It shall not be obligatory on the part of Naval Ship Repair Yard, Sri Vijaya Puram to offer any employment to any apprentice after completion of training nor shall it be obligatory for the apprentice to accept any employment.

13. MEDICAL FACILITIES & 14. TEXT BOOKS

13. Medical Facilities: Treatment for training-related injuries will be extended at Yard Medical Centre or referred to GB Pant Hospital at Sri Vijaya Puram.

14. Text Books: Textbooks may be supplied on loan as far as possible. Losses are to be made good by apprentices.

15. DISCIPLINE & 16. DISASSOCIATION FROM POLITICS

15. Discipline: Strict discipline must be maintained during training as per Apprentices Act 1961.

16. Politics: Apprentices are forbidden to join Labour Unions, participate in Trade Union activities, or take part in political activity.

| 17. SPORTS & 18. CLOTHING PROVIDED

17. Sports: Facilities for outdoor and indoor games are available off-period.

18. Clothing Provided: Two pairs of workshop overalls, one pair of safety shoes, two pairs of safety gloves, safety goggles, safety helmet, ear defender, and uniform (half sleeve shirt & trouser).

| 19. CONTRACT OF APPRENTICESHIP & INDENTURE

Selected candidates will execute a contract through online portal <https://apprenticeship.gov.in> under NAPS. Compensation guidelines apply for contract termination by either employer or apprentice.

| 20. GENERAL INFORMATION

- **20.1.** Apply online only through <https://apprenticeship.recttindia.in/>. No physical forms accepted.
- **20.3.** Retain hard copies for document verification; do not send by post.
- **20.5.** Provide valid personal mobile number and e-mail ID.
- **20.6.** Canvassing of any kind leads to immediate disqualification.
- **20.7.** Material suppression of facts or forged certificates will lead to cancellation and termination.
- **20.8.** Decision of CSY, NSRY (SVP) in all matters relating to eligibility and acceptance/rejection shall be final.
- **20.10.** Jurisdiction of court cases will be sitting bench of Calcutta High Court in Sri Vijaya Puram.

| 21. REJECTION OF CANDIDATURE

Candidature may be rejected due to incomplete application, lack of prescribed qualification, underage/wrong DOB, multiple applications, un-clear/disfigured photograph, or mismatch of name/father's name/DOB with Class 10/ITI certificate.
